The 2019 Pommard 1er Cru Clos de la Commaraine Monopole has turned out nicely, wafting from the glass with aromas of sweet berries, plums, exotic spices, raw cocoa, orange rind and peonies.

Medium to full-bodied, ample and fleshy, it's supple and succulent, with melting tannins and a pretty core of fruit.

This is a charming, immediate and open-knit Pommard that subverts dated stereotypes of the appellation.
